

PRIVACY POLICY

This Statement is provided in compliance with art. 13 of Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), pursuant to art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (Code for the Protection of Personal Data) and relates to all personal data processed in the manner indicated below.

DATA CONTROLLER

The Data Controller of the personal data collected is AISAM - Associazione Italiana di Scienze dell'Atmosfera e Meteorologia A.P.S., based in Rovereto (TN), via Fortunato Zeni 8 - email: segreteria@aisam.eu | info@icam2019.it

The personal data provided may be communicated to appropriately appointed recipients who will process the data in their capacity as data controllers and/or agents, in order to comply with contracts with the person concerned or related purposes.

DATA TRANSFER

In the event that personal data are transferred outside the European Union, for technical and operational purposes and to ensure a high level of continuity of service, the Data Controller shall ensure that the transfer is based on an adequacy decision by the Commission, in order to ensure that the level of protection of natural persons guaranteed by current legislation and in particular by EU Regulation 2016/679 is not compromised.

DATA COLLECTION

The processed personal data are collected as provided directly by the person concerned or collected automatically.

The data provided directly by the person concerned are all personal data that are provided to the Data Controller in any way, directly by the person concerned.

The data collected automatically are navigation data. These data, although not collected in order to be associated with the identity of the user, could indirectly, through processing and association with data collected by the owner, allow its identification.

Following the sending of newsletters, the platform used allows to detect the opening of a message and the clicks made within the newsletter itself, together with details of the ip and browser/device used. The collection of this data is fundamental for the functioning of the systems for implicit renewal of the treatment (see the section Treatment Modality) and an integral part of the operation of the sending platform.

PURPOSE OF TREATMENT

The provision of personal data has as a legal basis for processing contractual or pre-contractual requirements or the fulfillment of legal obligations to which the data controller is subject. For this reason, any refusal to process or any lack, inaccurate or partial provision of data may result in the inability to properly provide the service or the inability for the owner to respond to requests for information sent by the person concerned.

The provision of data related to sending of newsletters for promotional, commercial or research purposes is optional. A refusal to give consent to the treatment will make it impossible to be

updated about commercial initiatives and/or promotional campaigns, to receive offers or other promotional material.

REVOCATION OF CONSENT

The person concerned may revoke their consent to receive promotional and commercial communications immediately, by sending a request to the e-mail addresses segreteria@aisam.eu | info@icam2019.it or by clicking on the appropriate unsubscribe link that can be found in the footer of each promotional and commercial e-mail received.

RECIPIENTS

The personal data provided may be communicated to appropriately appointed recipients who will process the data in their capacity as data processors and/or persons in charge of the processing. The Data Controller shall not communicate to third parties any of the information of the people concerned without their consent, except where required by law. In any case, the disclosure of the personal data processed is excluded. TREATMENT MODALITY

Personal data are processed by automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected, providing in any case the annual verification of data stored in order to delete those considered obsolete, unless the law does not provide for filing obligations.

Data processing is normally carried out at the Data Controller's premises by external personnel or collaborators duly designated as data processors. Specific security measures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

Subscription and related processing are considered valid until the user unsubscribes, which is present in every email, or after 12 months from the last communication of which there is evidence of direct interaction (click, open, reply).

RIGHTS OF THE PERSON CONCERNED

Pursuant to Articles 15 - 21 of EU Regulation 2016/679, each person concerned is granted a series of rights.

- Right of Access: pursuant to Article 15, the people concerned have the right to obtain confirmation that personal data concerning them are being processed and, if necessary, to obtain a copy. They also have the right to obtain access to personal data concerning themselves and to further information such as the purpose of the processing, the categories of recipients, the period of storage of data and the rights that can be exercised.
- Right of rectification: pursuant to art. 16, the people concerned have the right to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning them or the integration of the same.
- Right to cancellation: the person concerned has the right to obtain the cancellation of personal data concerning them, without undue delay, if there is one of the reasons provided for in art. 17.
- Right of treatment limitation: the person concerned has the right, in the cases provided for in Article 18 of Regulation 2016/679, to obtain the limitation of treatment.

- Right to data portability: the interested party has the right to receive in a structured format, of common use and readable by automatic device, personal data concerning him and has the right to transmit such data to another owner without hindrance, as provided for in art. 20 of Regulation 2016/679;
- Right to object to the processing: the person concerned has the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning him according to the provisions of art. 21 of Regulation 2016/679.
- The interested party also has the right to lodge a complaint with the competent control authority, the Privacy Guarantor.

The requests referred to in the previous points must be addressed in writing to the Data Controller. The Data Controller will, within the time limits established by current legislation, provide a timely response to requests to exercise the rights of data subjects.

Any clarification or request for clarification may be addressed in writing to the Data Controller.

UPDATES AND MODIFICATIONS

The Data Controller reserves the right to modify, supplement or periodically update this Information in accordance with the applicable legislation or the provisions adopted by the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data.
